

Bolton, United Kingdom 18th September 2010

WEAPON: Men's and Women's Foil

AGE CATEGORY: Cadet boys and girls born in 1994 or younger

PROGRAM:

Saturday, 18th September

Last check in for men's foil 8:30
Last check in for women's foil 10:00

2 rounds of pools, direct elimination through to the final 9:00 – 18:30

VENUE: Bolton Arena, Arena Approach, Horwich, Bolton BL6 6LB, UK

The tournament takes place in the Bolton Arena, a state of the art centre built for the 2002 Commonwealth Games. The arena is located just off junction 6 of the M61. It is within 24 miles (40Km) of Manchester airport and 18 miles (30Km) of central Manchester.

ORGANISATION: The North-West Squad Club, Manchester Fencing Club and the British Fencing Association

COMPETITION FORMAT:

- Two rounds of pools of 6-7 fencers, approx. 25% eliminated after each round
- Direct elimination with repechage starting from Tableau 32
- Finals without fence-off for 3rd place
- Trophy for the top 4, medals for 5th to 8th place

EFC regulations will apply throughout the competition.

ENTRIES: The competition is open to all countries. Entry fee: €15 per fencer to be paid at check-in. A valid FIE license is required.

All entries must be made through the fencer's national federation via the EFC website before **August 25**th **2010**. As per the 2010-2011 EFC regulations, not more than 20 entries per country can be accepted apart from the host nation where a maximum of 64 are allowed.

EQUIPMENT: FIE standard equipment will be required, i.e., 800N clothing, 1600N mask and FIE approved blade. Printing of the fencer's name on the back of the jacket is **NOT** required.

REFERES: Each participating country must supply at its expense the number of qualified referees indicated in the table below:

Number of	Number of
Entries	Referees
1-4	0
5-9	1
10-15	2
16-20	3

Failure to comply with this rule will result in a 300 € fine for each referee short of the required number. This fee must be paid before any fencers from the offending country will be allowed to compete.

TRAVEL TO THE VENUE

The venue for the tournament is the Bolton Arena which is in Horwich, just outside of the town of *Bolton*. Close to the West Pennine moors It is just 10 miles (16 km) north west of the city of Manchester.

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS: Closest airport: Manchester, UK; Train station: Horwich.
